FROM THE PASTOR

Jesus asks, **"What are you looking for?"** When Jesus first meets a couple of John the Baptist's disciples who begin to follow Jesus, Jesus first shows interest in them. Jesus asks them to articulate their hopes and dreams. He listens to them. He shows them kindness.

It seems to be a little disarming to the two disciples. They ask Jesus where he is staying. Maybe they don't yet know if they can trust this new Messianic figure. Jesus is not put off by their inquiry. Nor does he respond with a bruised ego. Jesus simply welcomes them to "come and see." And as they say, "Life was never the same again!"

Two thoughts come to my mind as I ponder this encounter. One is, "how do we greet people?" Do we illustrate a genuine interest, inviting people to open themselves to us? Are we welcoming? Do we inquire with love and compassion? God forbid someone feels more interrogated than anything else. So, I pray to be gracious and welcoming as we greet people, people we already know and people we don't yet know.

The other thought is related to the fact Jesus asks about our hopes and dreams. Jesus wants to know what any of us are looking for. What a ponderous question! What are you looking for? Sometimes I think I know. Other times I think I have no idea.

I like John Dear's thought everyone is really looking for much the same: "love, goodness, truth, peace, happiness, justice, mystery and joy. We are looking for meaning." Of course, the trouble is while everyone may share a common end game, there is much disagreement over what leads to these things we are looking for.

I encourage you to take some time to ponder Jesus' question this summer season. Take some time to examine what you choose to think leads to the things you are looking for. May God's Spirit enlighten our journeys.

Please do your part to encourage parents, grandparents and others to share their children for a week of fun filled learning and loving.
